Steam Cleaning, Hot or Cold Pressure Washing

- 1. Use at a concentration of 1 part to 150 parts water, or by following the manufacturer's instructions.
- 2. Lightly wet the vehicle.
- 3. Spray on the NT20 Neutral Traffic Film Remover using even sweeps of the lance.
- 4. Turn off the detergent feed and thoroughly rinse the vehicle.

Manual Washing

- 1. Use at a concentration of 1 part to 150 parts water.
- 2. Lightly wet the vehicle.
- 3. Apply the solution generously with a sponge, cloth or vehicle exterior wash brush, starting at the highest point to be cleaned.
- 4. Rinse the vehicle thoroughly.
- 5. Allow the vehicle to dry or alternatively mop up the surplus liquid with a well wrung out sponge, cloth or leather.

Floor Cleaning – Manual

- 1. Use at a concentration of 1 part to 80 150 parts water.
- 2. Dose the product into a bucket filled with water and mop the floor to apply the solution.
- 3. Allow the product to act briefly and scrub, brush or mop depending on the type of soiling.
- 4. Remove the soiled solution from the floor with a clean mop.

Floor Cleaning - Machine - Light to Medium Soiling

- 1. Use at a concentration of 1 part to 80 150 parts water.
- 2. Dose the product into the full water tank of a single disc machine or scrubber drier and apply the solution to the floor surface.
- 3. Allow the product to act briefly and scrub, depending on the type of soiling.
- 4. Remove the soiled solution from the floor.

Floor Cleaning – Machine – Heavy Soiling

- 1. Use at a concentration of 1 part to 80 150 parts water.
- 2. Dose the product into the full water tank of a single disc machine or scrubber drier and apply the solution to the floor surface.
- 3. Scrub the floor without vet vacuuming. Allow the product to act briefly depending on the type of soiling.
- 4. Scrub a second time and directly wet vacuum the soiled solution.
